

1 - Sentence Structure

Sentences in English have a very strict word order. Basic sentences in English follow the Subject (S), Verb (V), Object (O) pattern: S-V-O




2 - Pronouns

Present Past **Future** Today and everyday Yesterday Tomorrow I walk to school. I walked to school. I will walk to school. Tom bikes to school. Tom biked to school. He will bike to school.
